After the private celebration of Mass each day, churches throughout the Diocese of Clonfert will open for individual prayer until normal closing times. Participation in Funeral Masses and Services/Wedding Masses and Services and the Celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism are to be limited to close family and friends not exceeding 100 people. During the liturgy additional health and safety measures will be in place. Your co-operation for the good of all is gratefully appreciated. The Celebration of the Sacraments of Confirmation/First Confession and First Holy Communion is postponed until further notice. Confessions and the Sacrament of the Sick will be celebrated as requested. However additional safety measures will apply. As Christians we are called to generously play our part and work for the common good by reaching out, as appropriate, to practically assist those who are impacted bt this situation. Please pray for those affected by the virus and for our civil leaders that they may make wise decisions. Pray also for all our health professionals, our carers and clergy who are working with those affected and for our scientists who are trying to understand what is happening.
