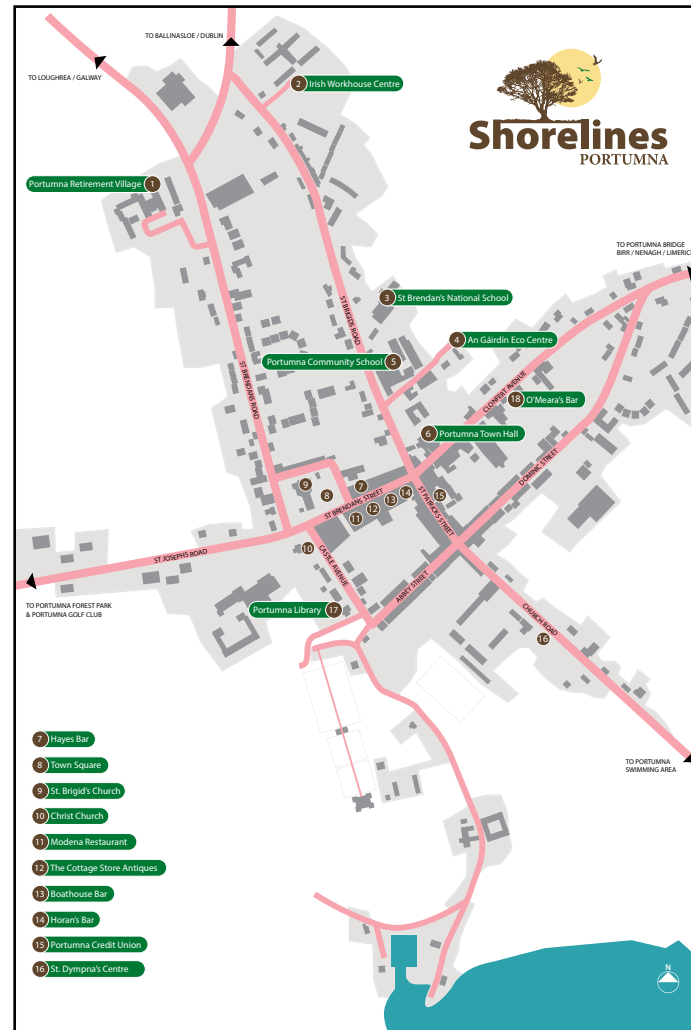

10 decades, 10 cubes explores the bonds between people and the land. Comprising 10 cubes of differing sizes, the sculpture documents the development of agriculture and its effects on Portumna during the period from 1917 to 2017. The sculpture references people's experiences of working and living from the land. *10 Decades, 10 Cubes* commemorates the local community's past struggles, resilience and resourcefulness and examines the challenges that face contemporary society. The cubes will be visible at multiple locations during the festival.



Aideen Monaghan is currently the Artist in Residence with the Anatomy Department at N.U.I. Galway. A graduate in Fine Art/Painting, she has exhibited at previous Shorelines exhibitions, many galleries in Galway and in

Iowa, U.S. Aideen was joint winner of the R.D.S. Taylor Award for Fine Art (2000), Winner of the Revenue Commissioners Purchase Prize (2000) and Recipient of a Galway County Council Arts Bursary (2005).




