

Portumna Castle Crafts Art Classes.

We run 3 different night classes on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, for 10 sessions each. As well as a longer 10 session Tuesday class, for those wishing to devote a whole day to their art. All these classes run twice a year, from early February until the end of April (with breaks in between to allow for National Holidays, such as St. Patrick's Day and Easter). Then again, from early September until the end of November. (*Breaking for a week around Halloween).

The evening classes begin at 7.30 p.m. and continue until 10.30 p.m., and our very popular day class begins at 10 a.m., finishing at 4 p.m., with an hours lunch break between 12.30 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. Light refreshments are provided in every class, and you can, at any time, stop and make yourself a drink or wander round the room to be inspired by what others people are doing. All classes are run from a purpose built well light art room, located in Youth Reach Portumna, on Abbey Street, Portumna. There is ample, free parking outside this building, and it also has a spacious lift to the second floor if required, where you will find the art-room.

First time students do not even need any art materials, as all the basic equipment will be at hand. This is an excellent opportunity to try out oils, acrylics, or watercolour's, and then decide for yourself what you wish to invest in buying, once you have experienced different techniques and mediums. Our very experienced tutor Wolf, will also advise you on the best quality to buy. You can also experiment with different drawing methods & materials, such as charcoal, pastels and pencil.

The classes cost €130 for 10 evening classes, and €160 for 10 day class session, payable in advance to 'Portumna Castle Crafts and Garden'. We also now have a Face Book Page of the same name, where you can keep up to date with what is happening in the classes and what our students are producing. Many go on to submit their work to the local Shorelines Art Festival, as well as other events.

Our tutor since the classes began is Wolf Lorien, an extremely patient and encouraging teacher, with a Degree and M.A. in Fine Art Painting from L.A.S.D.
